Workshop Descriptions:

Organizing a Tenant Association

This workshop will identify how to set up a tenant association. Participants will discuss the function of a tenant association and learn essential steps to take when setting up a TA. Participants will also learn about their right to organize and how organizing can be an effective way of getting things done.

Meeting Facilitation

The Facilitation workshop will teach you how to best prepare and carry out efficient tenant meetings for your association. You will get helpful hints on how to create fliers, spread the word about meetings, and overcome barriers to tenant participation in order to include everyone in the building.

Organizing a Campaign to Win

In this workshop, participants will learn how to develop a clear, effective strategy to address problems in their building. They will learn about key allies and resources they can reach out to for assistance in a campaign.

Maintaining and Strengthening a Tenant Association

This workshop will demonstrate how to keep tenants engaged in their tenant association after the initial “crisis” is over. The workshop will identify how to continue to fight for both larger and smaller issues in the building, and how to use those tools to keep the association strong.

Fighting Harassment

In this workshop, participants will learn what harassment is and how to address it. They will identify common methods of harassment and learn about tenants’ rights concerning harassment. The workshop will also teach tenants how to report harassment and how to fight it by using public allies and legal resources.

Building Conditions Issues

The Conditions workshop will teach tenants how the inspection process works in different buildings and the ways to document the issues that pertain to each tenant. It will also inform tenants about the rights they have when it comes to utilities and repairs for their apartments.
